Water Bottles in Class

As you are aware it is well researched that good hydration helps children to focus and concentrate on their work. Therefore, as previously in Strathmore we are happy for our pupils to have access to water throughout the day. In school we have access to water fountains and some parents choose for their child to bring in a bottle of water from home.
